Focus

Holiday vocabulary

Holiday descriptions and questions

Aim

To learn and practice holiday vocabulary and questions.

Preparation

Make one copy of the two-page worksheet for each student.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

40 minutes

Introduction

In this holiday vocabulary worksheet, students learn and practice words and questions related to holidays.

Procedure

Give each student a copy of the two-page worksheet.

Students start by completing an email about a holiday with words and phrases from a box.

Students then match holiday vocabulary from the email to definitions.

Exercise B - Answer key

Next, students unscramble words to make questions about holidays and then answer the questions using the information from the email.

Exercise C - Answers and possible replies.
