Aim

To learn and practice vocabulary and expressions related to ordering food and drink in a restaurant.

Preparation

Make one copy of the two-page worksheet for each student.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

In this restaurant language worksheet, students learn and practice vocabulary and expressions related to ordering food and drink in a restaurant.

Procedure

Give each student a copy of the two-page worksheet.

Students begin by completing a menu with headings.
