

Activity Type

Grammar and Speaking Game: asking and answering questions (group work)

Focus

Wh questions

Aim

To ask *Wh* questions that elicit certain answers.

Preparation

Make one copy of the cards for each group of four and cut as indicated.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

30 minutes

Introduction

In this *Wh* questions game, students ask *Wh* questions that elicit certain answers.

Procedure

Divide the students into groups of four.

Give each group a set of cards.

Ask the students to shuffle the cards and place them face-down in a pile on the table.

Students then take turns picking up a card and asking *Wh* questions that will elicit the word or phrase on the card.

Examples

Fine: How are you feeling today?

Happy: How do you feel when everything is going well?

Dessert: What do you eat after the main course of a meal?

In December: What month is Christmas?

At the cinema: Where do you watch movies?

The first student to answer with the correct word or phrase wins, and keeps the card.

The next student then picks up a card, and so on.

The student with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.
