Aim

To ask and answer
questions that contain
dependent prepositions
with verbs and
adjectives.

Preparation

Make one copy of the
worksheet for each
student.

Level

Intermediate (B1)

Time

30 minutes

Introduction

In this dependent prepositions activity, students ask and answer questions that contain dependent prepositions with verbs and adjectives.

Procedure

Give each student a copy of the worksheet.

Tell the students that they are going to review common dependent prepositions with verbs and adjectives.

Students then complete questions on the worksheet with prepositions that they think match with the verbs and adjectives.

When the students have finished, go through the answers with the class.

Next, students write their own answers to the questions in the 'My answer' column.

After that, students ask the questions to their classmates to try to find other people with the same answers.

When a student finds someone with the same answer, they write the person's name in the 'Name' column next to the corresponding question and ask follow-up questions to gain more information, noting down the answers in the last column.

Finally, students give feedback to the class on what they found out.

If there are any interesting findings, encourage the students to discuss them in more detail.
